- If any children are going to Hayes Meadow School this September and need wrap around care please speak to Louise or Debbie who can let you know about our 'Big Kidz Club'.

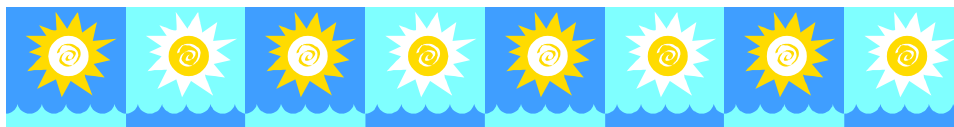
Important Dates
